APPLICATION FOR PRETRIAL DIVERSION—CRIMINAL

To be considered for participation in the Pretrial Diversion Program, the following application must be completed in its entirety, and submitted to the Cherokee County Attorney's Office not more than 30 days after the date of arraignment (misdemeanors) or first appearance (felonies). Your application must be accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee of \$75 (misdemeanors) or \$100 (felonies), in the form of a cashier's check, money order, or firm check, made payable the Cherokee County Attorney Diversion Fee Fund. If Pretrial Diversion is granted, a signed Diversion Agreement must be filed not less than 14 days prior to trial (misdemeanors) or preliminary hearing (felonies). The applicant is responsible for continuing such trial or hearing as may be necessary.
