Defense counsel requests the following items which are or have been in the possession, custody, or control of the prosecution, the existence of which is known, or by the exercise of due diligence may become known, and which will not place an unreasonable burden on the prosecution:

- (1) Copies of written or recorded statements or confessions made by the defendant, the codefendant(s), and witnesses.
- (2) Results or reports of physical or mental examinations, and of scientific tests or experiments made in connection with the particular case, or copies thereof.
- (3) Recorded testimony of the defendant before a grand jury or at an inquisition.
- (4) Memoranda of any oral confession made by the defendant and a list of the witnesses to such confession.
- (5) Copies of, or the opportunity to inspect, relevant books, papers, reports, documents, audio recordings, video recordings, tangible objects, buildings, or places, or copies, or portions thereof.
- (6) A summary or written report of what any expert witness intends to testify to on direct examination, including the witness' qualifications and opinions, at a reasonable time prior to trial by agreement of the parties or by order of the court.
- (7) Any exculpatory evidence.
- (8) Additional items requested: _____

By making this Request for Discovery, defense counsel agrees to:

- (1) Permit the attorney for the prosecution to inspect, and copy or photograph scientific or medical reports, books, papers, documents, tangible objects, or copies or portions thereof, which the defense intends to produce at any hearing, are material to the case, and will not place an unreasonable burden on the defense.
- (2) Provide for the attorney for the prosecution a summary or written report of what any expert witness intends to testify, including the witness' qualifications and the witness' opinions, at a reasonable time prior to trial by agreement of the parties or by order of the court.
